

MEMBERSHIP PAYMENT INFORMATION

PAYMENT METHODS

1. When paying in advance, e-transfers are preferred and transferred to ljo.office@gmail.com (on the message line of e-transfers **YOU MUST** put your child's first name and last initial as well as the reason for payment)
2. Cheques are payable to La Jeunesse Youth Orchestra Inc. (no short forms please) when paying in installments

LJYO MEMBERSHIP PAYMENT FOR FAMILIES WITH 2 OR MORE STUDENT MEMBERS

- Families who have 2 or more student members in LJYO will pay the full registration fee for the first member, and half the registration fee for each additional student member.
- All families will be responsible to pay one payment of \$200 for fundraising.
- We will also need a \$25 personal, post-dated cheque for each member's music folder dated, May 1, 2023. **No e-transfers for the music folder deposit, please. These cheques will be destroyed after May 1, 2023.**
- Alternatively, you can purchase a brand-new music folder for \$25

****We ask families that all cheques be completely filled in prior to registration day in order to do this in a timely manner and get everyone through in our time frame.***

Payment Options for Orchestra Members

Option #1 (you can combine the Registration Fee, Fundraising Fee and Tickets as one e-transfer {\$950} with this option)

\$300.00 Registration Fee (e-transfer due by Wed., Sept. 14, 2022, or cheque due on Sat., Sept. 17, 2022)
\$200.00 Family Fundraising Fee (e-transfer due by Wed., Sept. 14, 2022, or cheque due on Sat., Sept 17, 2022)
\$450.00 \$15 Tickets at all three in-person concerts (10 tickets x 3 concerts) purchased in advance to be distributed to your family and friends if you choose to do so (e-transfer due by Wed., Sept. 14, 2022, or cheque due on Sat., Sept. 17, 2022)
\$25.00 Music Folder Deposit (must be a personal cheque , post-dated May 1, 2022) cheque is destroyed at the end of the orchestra season as long as the folder is returned with music in good shape OR purchase a brand-new folder on Registration Day for \$25

Option #2 (you can combine the Registration Fee and Fundraising Fee as one e-transfer {\$500} with this option)

\$200.00 Family Fundraising Fee (e-transfer due by Wed., Sept. 14, 2022, or cheque due on Sat., Sept 17., 2022)
\$150.00 for 10, "Home for the Holidays" advance tickets at \$15 each (post-dated cheque dated November 26, 2022, due on Sat., Sept. 17, 2022). The "Home for the Holidays" Concert is on Saturday, Dec. 5, 2022.
\$150.00 for 10, "In the Spotlight" advance tickets at \$15 each (post-dated cheque dated February 25, 2023, due on Sat., Sept. 17, 2022) The "In the Spotlight" concert is on Saturday, Mar. 4, 2023.
\$150.00 for 10, "Springtime with the Symphony" advance tickets at \$15 each (post-dated cheque dated April 29, 2023, due on Sat., Sept 17, 2022) The "Sonic Bloom" concert is on Saturday, May 6, 2023.
\$25.00 Music Folder Deposit (must be a personal cheque , post-dated May 1, 2022) cheque is destroyed at the end of the orchestra season as long as the folder is returned with music in good shape OR purchase a brand-new folder on Registration Day for \$25

\$300.00 Registration Fee (e-transfer due by Wed., Sept. 14, 2022, or cheque due on Sat., Sept. 17, 2022)
\$200.00 Family Fundraising Fee (post-dated cheque dated May 1, 2023, due on Sat., Sept 17, 2022)
\$150.00 for 10, "Home for the Holidays" advance tickets at \$15 each (post-dated cheque dated November 26, 2022, due on Sat., Sept. 17, 2022). The "Home for the Holidays" Concert is on Saturday, Dec. 5, 2022.
\$150.00 for 10, "In the Spotlight" advance tickets at \$15 each (post-dated cheque dated February 25, 2023, due on Sat., Sept 17, 2022) The "In the Spotlight" concert is on Saturday, Mar. 4, 2023.
\$150.00 for 10, "Springtime with the Symphony" advance tickets at \$15 each (post-dated cheque dated April 29, 2023, due on Sat., Sept 17, 2022) The "Sonic Bloom" concert is on Saturday, May 6, 2023.

\$25.00 Music Folder Deposit (**must be a personal cheque**, post-dated May 1, 2022) cheque is destroyed at the end of the orchestra season as long as the folder is returned with music in good shape **OR** purchase a brand-new folder on Registration Day for \$25

Please note: Advance tickets purchased can be used toward either in-person or virtual ticket sales. Names, phone numbers and email addresses will need to be provided for each ticket to be included on either our virtual list or in-person list. Details will follow closer to the concerts as to whom you will send this information.

FUNDRAISING

Families are required to contribute towards fundraising and that is what the \$200 payment is for. Traditionally, there are opportunities to participate in parent fundraising programs to offset this \$200 cost (e.g. poinsettia fundraiser and Flip Give). Flip Give and Poinsettia Sales are parent fundraisers! These fundraisers are the ones initiated by parents and run by parents with consultation from our LJYO Fundraising Committee. We hope to have parents implement other fundraisers during this season with consideration, of course, given to the pandemic and possible restrictions. If you participate in LJYO parent-run fundraisers this season and raise money, then LJYO will issue you a cheque for that amount sometime in **May 2023, to help offset your Fundraising Fee.**

For example:

Fundraising Fee	\$200.00
Family raises	\$100.00
LJYO Reimburses	\$100.00
